



FAQs – for our Dance Program “COVID STYLE”

What is the start date for the new season?

TUESDAY, Sept. 8th - June 19, 2021

If we opt for “zoom” to start, can we switch to “in person” at some point?

Absolutely! Pending State regulations of #s at the time. We will keep all updated as the rules change.

We are starting with a strict "in person" limit - along with virtual links of all classes. As restrictions are lifted... we will be able to open the in-person class options to the "next in line" on the waiting list.

*You can register for BOTH options, HOWEVER, be sure to select “**WAIT LIST**” for an “in person” class, if you plan to start with “zoom”. This will hold your next place in line should you decide to switch from zoom to in person.

If you are on a “waitlist” you will NOT be charged for the class.

What are your max class sizes?

Preschool, Intermediate & Level 6/7 Classes will be assigned their own clearly marked, designated 6’ dance space.

Levels 1-5 we are limiting class sizes to a 12’ dance space.

The studio location will determine the class size.

Will every class be offering ZOOM options?

Yes indeed! Every studio will be equipped and instructors will be trained on how to “manage” in-person AND zoom students.

What will Tuition look like this year?

Tuition is remaining the same as last year.

Virtual ZOOM classes are the same cost as the in person class.

How do I select IN PERSON Classes vs ZOOM Classes?

You will see the option of selecting your choice upon registration.

What if my dancer/s are placed on a waiting list for “IN PERSON” classes?

We encourage your dancer/s to take the class virtually until restrictions are lifted.

At that time we will be able to accommodate & transition dancers in the order registration was received.

What will drop off/pickup look like for Jennersville?

****Parents and Students must wear face coverings during drop off and pickup****

Drop off at the front door - or walk dancer to the front door

We will have 6' spot markers on the sidewalk (front, side & back of building)

There will be a temperature taker at the door

Dancer enter into their classroom

Teacher will direct student to their space

AFTER class:

Students will pack up and get ready to go.

A staff member will lead class out the back door, around the side of the building to meet their parents.

Parents will need to park, and meet their dancer at the LEFT side of the building, beside The Growing Place “Nursery”. There will be socially distanced markers on the sidewalk.

*Levels 1-5 may walk on their own from the back of the building, to the parking lot & to their car.

What will drop off/pickup look like for Kennett?

Drop off at the front door - or walk dancer to the front door

We will have 6' spot markers at the entrance.

There will be a temperature taker at the door.

Dancers enter into their classroom.

Teacher will direct student to their space

AFTER class:

Students will pack up and get ready to go.

A staff member will lead class out the side doors.

Parents will need to park, and meet their dancer at the side of the building.

There will be socially distanced markers on the pavement.

*Levels 1-5 may walk on their own from the side door, to the parking lot & to their car.

What if my child has a “break” between classes?

We encourage all to leave and come back if possible. If this is not an option, we will have very limited space for the students in the lobby. All students must wear face coverings.

What is the protocol you will follow if a student begins feeling ill during class?

We will immediately do a temp check. If the temp is 100.4 or higher they will be removed from the room and a parent will be called promptly to come pickup their dancer. The student will wait in the office until their ride arrives.

The remainder of the class will be sent to the lobby with their face coverings, while the studio is thoroughly sanitized.

If in person classes fill, with a long enough waitlist, would you alternate weeks of in-person instruction and zoom instruction?

At this time we are not planning to design an alternating schedule for in-person classes, however, we are open to that as a possibility on a class by class basis as necessary.

How will you handle costumes this year?

At this time we are simply focusing on getting our dancers back into the studio. However, we are aware that there are many different scenarios, unknown factors, and financial concerns at this time. We will be revisiting our typical recital planning with this in mind.
